ALL NOMINATIONS ARE DUE BY: OCTOBER 2, 2009

Pioneer: The nominee statement should include, but not be limited to: years of service in the field of organ transplantation (**must have a minimum of 10 years of service**), current title in the medical field, professional medical associations in organ transplantation, any first of a kind or other consistent contributions to advance the cause of minority organ donation and transplantation in the medical and publications in medical journals.

Corporate: The nominee statement should include but not be limited to: years of dedication and services in health care and organ transplantation, any contributions in the advancement of organ transplantation, state future involvement in health care, contributions or in-kind support focused on organ and tissue donation and transplantation..

Community Leader: The nominee statement should include but not be limited to: current position accomplishments to help educate the public on the importance of organ donation and transplantation, professional community associations, personal experiences in organ donation. The nominee must have advanced the cause of organ and tissue transplantation in a volunteer position (non-paid).

Patient Advocacy: This nominee statement should include but not be limited to: affiliations with professional medical associations in organ and tissue transplantation, current position, dedication to improve the lives of patients who need a transplant, publications in medical journals on organ transplantation, outstanding contributions in the field of organ transplantation, any personal experiences with organ transplantation
